

SUSC Labor Day Friendlies **Event Rules and Guidelines**

All tournament games will be played in accordance with the laws of the game unless modified herein.

- **Ball Size/Game Duration:** U10 – U12 size 4 ball 2 x 30 minute halves (5 min. half time)
U13 and U14 size 5 ball 2 x 35 minute halves (5 min. half time)

- **Rosters and Players Passes:** A certified US Club or USYSA roster shall be submitted to tournament officials prior to first game and may be checked by field marshals or referees prior to each game. Club managers need to make sure that jersey numbers coincide with the player's name as shown on the roster.

- **Number of Players:** Each team may be composed of a maximum of 20 players for this event and the rosters are limited to four guest players.

- **SUSC Labor Day Friendlies "Club Pass":** Any club traveling to the SUSC Spring Invitational with more than one team may choose to move a player up for any game throughout the event. However, no player is allowed to play in more than four games at the event. The player and coach must have permission from their club director and subsequently from the tournament director before writing the player onto the game roster and presenting his or her pass of the same club during pre-game check-in.

- **Substitutions:** Substitutions are unlimited but may only be made with the referees permission at the following times:
 1. Prior to throw-ins in your team's favor and whenever the opposing team substitutes a player during this stoppage.
 2. Prior to a goal kick by either team.
 3. After a goal has been scored.
 4. When play has been stopped for injury.
 5. After half time.

- **Field Size:** For all U11 games a standard 8v8 field will be used. U12 age teams will have the choice to enter into a 11v11 bracket or an 8v8 bracket.

- **Results/Standings:** Results will be recorded after every game by the SUSC Field Marshall's and posted on the SUSC website. However, at the conclusion of the event no placements will be determined nor will there be any awards type ceremonies.
